

## 51 WAYS TO INTEGRATE PATHWAYS INTO YOUR CLUB

To help current members, new members and guests understand and get excited about Pathways, it's important to integrate Pathways into your club. Below are a "few" ideas to get you started. 1. Share brief description of Pathways
2. Talk about the Pathways ice breaker
3. Talk about Pathways evaluation form
4. Show the How to Evaluate tutorial
5. Have members share which path they selected and their experience
6. Talk about the Pathways Mentoring Program
7. Put Pathways description handout and "Where will Pathways take you" flier in guest packet
8. Do online demonstration of selecting a path
9. Do online tutorials of working in projects
10. Give Pathways pin to those giving Pathways Ice Breaker
11. Give Pathways level ribbon to those completing levels
12. Present certificate to those completing levels
13. Have pathways-themed open house
14. Show Base Camp reports of member progress
15. Highlight brief description of a Path journey
16. Give brief overview of an elective project
17. Give brief overview of a required project
18. Talk about Level 1 project requirements
19. Share stories from other members, or Toastmasters magazine or Facebook
20. Have members share what they learned or enjoyed about their completed project
21. Share member's Pathways experience on club Facebook page
22. In speech introductions, mention path, Level and project
23. Have a "download" a path meeting
24. Reach out to members who may need help learning Base Camp
25. Give feedback badges in Base Camp to each other
26. Monitor member progress in Base Camp
27. Display Pathways member progress chart
28. Have club Secretary help monitor member progress in Base Camp
29. Have all officers select a path so they can assist members
30. If corporate club, work with HR to show how Pathways aligns with employee development
31. Have a Pathways Ice Breaker speech-a-thon
32. Send new members (and interested guests) *The Navigator*
33. Do your Pathways Ice Breaker on how you selected your path and why
34. Attend District Pathways support sessions and TLIs
35. Write an article for your local paper about Pathways to attract guests to your club
36. Share path to DTM in Pathways
37. Have group Pathways mentoring sessions for new members
38. Give tutorial of how to give feedback badges in Base Camp
39. Show how to request feedback from fellow members in Base Camp
40. Show how to upload documents to Pathways
41. Give Base Camp quick tour tutorial
42. Show how to access Tutorials and Resources in Base Camp
43. Show how Ice Breaker project can be found on regular Toastmaster site
44. Ask other Toastmasters for ideas
45. Have regular Pathways Q&A sessions
46. Have a club Pathways mentor
47. Conduct Pathways learning/training sessions
48. Have people bring back what they learned about Pathways at TLI
